2.Hell reminds me of how much God

(Luke 16:24-25) ... Father Abraham, have pity on me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, because I am in agony in this fire.' But Abraham replied, 'Son...

(Ezekiel 18:23) God takes no pleasure in the death of the wicked. (Luke 16:30) If someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent. (Jeremiah 17:9) Our hearts are desperately wicked.

(John 3:16) For God so LOVED the world that He gave His only son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
